	Garrowhill Post Office has now closed meaning another local amenity being lost. Now an ice cream parlour.
	EB asked if there was a possibility of the Co-op being interested in operating. She will speak to the local manager to investigate.

Citizens Advice Bureau visited the City Chambers recently – information provide to be put on the CC website.

Various communii8ty councilors noted the lack of gritting in the area during the recent bad spell of weather. It was noted that neighbouring council NLC and SLC had gritted roads.

MP2 noted that pavements and roads around Garrowhill Train Station had not been gritted and walking was treacherous. AH noted there was no gritting of pavements around primary schools. (MP2 noted that the gritter had been in evidence on Maxwell Drive near the school – but only on the road.

CC asked if grit bins are not being filled for use of residents.

Generally it was agreed that areas around schools should have priority. Noted that council has provided a map of the priority areas for gritting. Maxwell Drive should have been included. (Map to be added to CC website.)
