1) Police Scotland

5) Councillor Turner

- There is a council boundary review underway and is likely to result in representation in the district reducing from 4 to 3
- Recent resurfacing on Garrowhill Drive has now been completed.
- LES undertook to examine the fence on the elevated pavement on Glasgow Road.
- LES will monitor street cleaning in the Garforth Road / Mount Vernon Avenue
- A list of potholes to be repaired in the district is still on-going.
- 20mph signs on some streets in the area have become faded and need to be refreshed or replaced.
- Bins in Garrowhill Park not being cleared
- The swing park at Garrowhill Park is still being used by dog walkers
- The graffiti removal team have been active in the district.
- Cllr Turner is awaiting a response from the LES concerning speeding drivers in Garrowhill
- There are still some drainage issues in the area with some clogged up.
- It has been reported that some road markings require to be reinstated.

6) Baillieston Area Partnership

- A grant for the upgrade for our website has been approved with a sum of £450 allocated.
- Discussion took place concerning the current school provision taking account of the significant number of new houses built in the area in the past year or so. Some catchment areas have very little capacity left.
